ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for the procurement of services for the “Town of Ware, Aeration Tank Sludge Removal and Cleaning Services Procurement” will be received by the Department of Public Works at the Town Hall, 126 Main St., Ware, MA 01082 until 11:00 a.m. local time on June 27, 2019 at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read aloud in the Selectmen’s Meeting Room. Sealed Bids must have outer envelope marked as “Town of Ware, Aeration Tank Sludge Removal and Cleaning Services Procurement.”

The work consists of removing sludge and grit from within the aeration tank, cleaning tank walls and floor, deragging mechanical equipment, and legally disposing of all removed material. Bids shall be on a lump sum basis as indicated in the Bid Form.

All Bids for this project are subject to the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 30B.

Prospective bidders must complete a one-time registration process on the web site to receive log-in credentials. Bidders must log in to the web site to download bidding documents for the project. Bidders will be added to the “planholders” or prospective bidders list upon downloading the bidding documents for the project. Bidding documents may also be examined at the office of Tighe & Bond, Inc., 120 Front Street, Suite 7, Worcester, Massachusetts between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, legal holidays excluded.

A bid deposit shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

Bids will be evaluated in accordance with the criteria stated in the Invitation for Bids by the person(s) designated by the Town Dept. of Public Works to perform such evaluations. Following evaluation, the Town will issue a Notice of Award, if at all, to the responsive and responsible Bidder whose bid presented the lowest responsive price within 60 calendar days of the receipt of bids. The time for award may be extended for up to 90 calendar days by mutual agreement between the Town and the responsive and responsible Bidder.

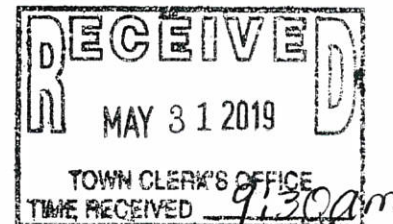
