

Purpose:

This guideline will assure notification of first responder agencies, town agencies, and other emergency notifications of personnel needed to respond to working fires.

Scope:

The guideline will be followed by Ware Fire Department members who are dispatching for incidents involving working fires.

Notification:

When a working fire has been confirmed the following notifications shall be made.

- Ware Police Department for traffic and scene control (967-3571). If Ware Police are unavailable State Police in Belchertown (323-7561).
- Chief of Department if not on scene or responding. Home (967-5774) Cell (413-531-4250)
- National Grid (Massachusetts Electric) (800-770-7936)
- If hydrant or hydrants are being utilized Ware DPW Director or Water Division personnel.
- American Red Cross if displaced victims.
- Ware Building Inspector (Any structure Fire)
- Fire Investigative Unit (Ware Police, Ware Fire, and State Fire Marshal)
- Ware Board of Health if food or sanitation concerns.
- Railroad if operations are near rail tracks.
