Minutes of Demolition Request meeting:

We met in the Town Hall Selectmen's Meeting Room.

Today the Ware Historical Commission met to consider a request from Anna Rossis 546 Main Street, Athol, for a demolition of the top floor of the Robinson-Hitchcock building at 114-116 Main Street in Ware. This building is listed on the Massachusetts State Register of Historic Places (NRDOE). The building is a treasure we must seek to save. and we voted 5 in favor of enacting the 9 month demolition delay by-law.

We notified Ms. Rossis that the Commission meets on the fourth Monday of each month at 6:00 in the Town Hall, and told her that she was already on the agenda for 1/22/18! The letter additionally told her that if she was unable to attend this meeting, that we would be happy to work with her to find a time that would suit her. She was also informed that as a condition of Ware's Demolition Delay By-Law, she is required by law to meet and work with the Commission during the 9 month delay.
