



COA Meeting Minutes July, 2018

- In attendance C. Brundige, J Cappe , J. Ciejka, C. Wloch, J. Zienowicz
- J. Ciejka called the meeting to order at 9:00 am.
- Motion to accept June 2018 Minutes, Cappe, all in favor.

Comments and Concerns:

- Pat Smola suggested that the COA arrange a trip to the Big E in the fall. Wloch will research dates and times and create a sign-up sheet for the front desk.
- There was also a concern voiced that items being taken from the “free” table at the Senior Center were being sold at private tag sales. Zienowicz explained that the COA has no control over items once they leave the building. People can choose to keep them and use them, they can throw them away or they can choose to sell them, it is their property.

New Business:

- Lunch policy review; the COA discussed using a tiered rate system for lunch fees to be more accommodating to people that can't afford to pay full rate (\$2.75) for meals every day. The agreement came to a three tiered system to keep things simple. Also a coupon booklet will replace gift certificates and pre-paid meals. Starting August 1st 2018, all patrons will pay \$2.75 at the front desk for lunch unless deemed eligible for Financial Relief by filling out the application and returning it to Maire Brighid Bresnahan for review. Motion; Ciejka, all in favor.
- Zienowicz stated that there will be a 2nd Annual Craft Fair at the Senior Center on November 17th from 10-3pm with over 20 vendors.
- Motion to not hold a COA meeting in August; Brundige, all in favor
- Motion to adjourn 10am – Ciejka, all in favor
