TOWN OF WARE ANNUAL CENSUS 2020

Town of Ware Census forms will be mailed to residents in the next week and this is not to be confused with the Federal Census which will be done sometime in March of this year.

Residents who receive census forms at their current address, including those addressed to an address which may have been vacant in a previous year are asked to review any printed information, make changes as needed, additions if you have a family member who is not listed, sign and date and return as quickly as possible in the enclosed envelope. Forms may also be dropped off at the Town Clerks Office only if you find that easier. There is an outside drop box located on the lower level near the office entry door if you find this easier.

A resident who receives a census at the address which may have been vacant is requested to complete information on members of their households also. It is a fact that we need to receive the information as Ware like other communities in MA receives funding based on total residents (adults and children) for various grants and state funded programs.

Please do not include any other information in the census envelope provided (no tax bills and/or payments; no dog licensing request; no items for other departments) as envelopes are opened as quickly as possible but in the past envelopes have not been received and/or have been forwarded to other departments causing a delay in receipt of your timely payments for taxes, water, etc.

Remember – the Commonwealth of MA requires that all registered voters return their census each year or they will be made Inactive as a voter and there will be additional paperwork to complete prior to your voting at any of the elections.
